**G•L•O•R•I•F•Y T•H•E L•O•R•D:** A good verse sampler is the acrostic **GLORIFY THE LORD**. If a person memorized two a week Monday and Thursday they'd be done in less than two months. They're life-changing, if applied!

## Thanksgiving:

## Lordship:

who does the will of my Father  
who is in heaven.

Do nothing from rivalry or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.
